Syllabus:

- Basic anatomy and physiology
- First person on scene and scene safety
- Levels of response and GCS
- Basic life support and CPR
- Advanced airway management (OP, NP, I-gel airways and suction)
- Simple ECG recognition
- Heart conditions and arrhythmias
- Use of AED
- Patient observations: Temperature, Blood pressure, blood sugar, capillary refill
- Oxygen therapy
- Mechanism of injury
- Secondary survey
- Treatment of head trauma including SCAT test
- Treatment of abdominal trauma
- C-spine control and use of collars
- Motorcycle helmet removal



- Control of severe haemorrhage
- Treatment of burns
- Treatment and immobilisation of fractures including basic splinting
- Treatment of dislocation
- Entonox therapy
- Recovery position including spinal recovery
- Treatment of soft tissue injuries
- Recognition and treatment of thermal conditions
- Recognition and treatment of shock
- Recognition and treatment of Anaphylaxis including use of EpiPen
- Recognition and treatment of Strokes
- Treatment of choking casualties
- Recognition and treatment of epilepsy
- Recognition and treatment of Diabetes including blood sugar monitoring

- Introduction to recreational drugs
- Patient handover to emergency services
- Introduction to safeguarding and the Mental Capacity Act
