 1. Identify hazards:
 - Fire triangle.
 - Classification of fires.
 - Ignition, fuel and oxygen sources.
 2. Identify people at risk:
 - Spread of fire.
 - Convection, conduction and radiation.
 3. Evaluate, remove, reduce and protect from risk:
 - Fire precautions.
 - Fire detection and warning.
 - Fire evacuation.
 - Human behaviour.
 - Signage.
 - Fire fighting.
 - Fire protection.
 - Management systems.
 4. Record, plan, instruct, inform and train:
 - Fire action plan.
 - Emergency plan.
 - Maintenance records.
 - Instruction, information and training.
 - Fire marshals/fire wardens.
 - Fire drill.
 5. Review.
